- 6. Includes health or social science professionals collaborating in the field of general practice. Excluded are industry representatives.
- 7. An accompanying person is defined as a partner, friend, or adult child (18+) with no scientific, professional, or commercial interest in the conference. The following may not register as accompanying persons:
- Colleagues or associates in general practice or related fields.
- Students enrolled in medical or health programs.
