Status confirmation is required from the responsible training or research institution in the relevant country/region. 5. Undergraduate students. Student status confirmation is mandatory and must be provided by the university. 6. Includes health or social science professionals collaborating in the field of general practice. Excluded are industry representatives. 7. An accompanying person is defined as a partner, friend, or adult child (18+) with no scientific, professional, or commercial interest in the conference. The following may not register as accompanying persons: – Colleagues or associates in general practice or related fields. – Students enrolled in medical or health programs.
